All event permits require public liability insurance coverage with a minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 listing the NCC as additional insured. Address: "The National Capital Commission, 202-40 Elgin Street, Ottawa ON K1P 1C7".

All event permits require a completed event application form. Application fee timeline is based on the date the event permit application form is received by the NCC.

¹Urban parks in the core area: Note that as of April 2026, events will be charged based on use of site instead of length of possession.

²Recreational pathways/trails: Urban and Greenbelt pathways are limited to 250 people with no daily fee cap for the use of multiple connected trails. Gatineau Park pathways and trails are limited to 500 people, and the daily fee for multiple connected trail usage is capped at the cost of a full-day or half-day parkway fee based on the event schedule.

³Interprovincial vehicular bridges: Note that as of April 2026, bridge fees will be applicable for the use of vehicular lanes.

⁴Half-day fee applies for:

- Parkways and interprovincial vehicular bridges: The event, including setup and teardown, ends no later than 12 pm.
- Multimedia productions: Filming, including setup and teardown, lasts a total of 3 hours or less, for non-exclusive site access only.
