Conditions

The following are some key conditions that will appear on any permit issued to you. Please read them carefully before making your reservation for a wedding ceremony.

- The fee for a wedding ceremony permit is **\$510** before taxes and **\$145 for each additional hour**. This permit gives you the right to hold a wedding ceremony on the grounds of the Mackenzie King Estate in one of three approved sites:
 - Abbey Ruins
 - Window on the Forest
 - Arc de Triomphe
- The permit is valid for three hours, including set-up and take-down.
- The permit must be paid in full at the time of signature, and must be signed at least 30 days before the event.
- No refunds will be issued less than 30 days before the event.
- The Mackenzie King Estate does not have an alternative site in case of rain.
- The wedding ceremony permit does not guarantee exclusive use of the site. A ceremony must not keep other visitors from circulating freely and must not prevent access to any part of the site.
- This historic site is recommended for ceremonies with fewer than 50 guests.
- Vehicle access fees are not included in the cost of the permit. Please contact us for more information.
- No receptions can be held at the Mackenzie King Estate: no caterer or reception area is available on-site.
- No vehicles are allowed on the Estate's roads or paths. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking spaces.
- Any chairs brought to the site must be transported on foot from the parking lot, and their set-up and take-down are included in the three hours of the permit.
- Sound amplifying equipment, fires, signage, candles, confetti and rice are not permitted.
- There is no electricity available.
- Celebratory horn honking is not permitted in order to respect the tranquility of Gatineau Park.
- Alcohol is not permitted on NCC property.
- Prior to leaving the site, and at the applicant's sole expense, the applicant shall return the site to the condition in which it was found, to the satisfaction of the NCC.
- If the site is not returned to its original condition, the NCC may undertake to do so, and the applicant will be responsible to reimburse the NCC for the costs and expenses incurred, in addition to paying an administrative fee of \$100 plus applicable taxes, immediately upon receipt of the invoice from the NCC.
- The applicant agrees to use the site at the applicant's own risk and peril, and accepts the site as is.
- The applicant shall ensure that no material is attached to any existing vegetation, structure or improvement of any nature whatsoever found at the site, including any fence, tree, plant, flower or statue, and shall ensure that no such vegetation, structure or improvement is removed or damaged.
- The applicant shall, at the applicant's sole expense, comply with all laws, regulations and rules in force in Gatineau Park, including all federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations.
